THIS WEEK'S THOUGHT:

In today's Gospel, we read about the verbal exchange between Jesus and the crowd. The people are asking questions about tangible material things. Jesus' answers call them, and us, to conversion to see things differently. They wanted to see signs; He wanted them to see that He was the only "Sign" necessary. They were still thinking about the bread that satisfied them; He wanted them to understand that He Himself was the bread that satisfies all hunger.
