THIS WEEK'S THOUGHT:

This week, we celebrate the lives of two great saints and doctors of the Church. Saint Jerome provided the Church the Latin Vulgate, the official Latin translation of the Bible and a number of commentaries on Sacred Scriptures. He had great love of Holy Scripture as well as a deep understanding of the Word of God. Saint Therese of Lisieux, the beloved "Little Flower", gave us the "Little Way" of finding a path to God in the smallest ways. She is an example to us of a humble life of simplicity and humility.

CATHOLIC PRACTICES:

It is always beneficial to be reminded about the proper manner to receive the Eucharist at Mass. To begin with, when we approach the Minister of Communion, we should do so in a reverent manner with our hands folded. We should make a bow at the waist when we are standing behind the person receiving Communion. If we are to receive the Holy Eucharist in our hand, we should place one hand over the other and lift them up so the Minister of Communion can place the Eucharist in our hand. Approaching the altar to receive and returning to our seat, our posture should show reverence to Jesus Christ. It is ***NOT*** a time for conversation or shaking hands with others. It is a solemn privileged moment for all.

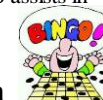
