

NOTES FROM THE PASTOR



My Dear Friends in Christ,

Today the Church steps out of its "ordinal" system (of marking the Weeks of the Liturgical Year numerically) and celebrates The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. This feast celebrates a double anniversary: firstly, it commemorates the construction of the Anastasis (which sits above the empty tomb of Jesus and a basilica, the Martyrium; secondly, it commemorates the discovery of the Lord's Cross by the empress, St. Helena in the year 320.

For us as Catholic-Christians, the Holy Cross of Christ is a central focal point for prayer and worship, as well as a reminder to us of the sacrifice which the Lord made for us on the cross. Having been ordained 30 years ago at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross, Christ's Cross is of importance to me as a hallmark of the beginning of my priestly ministry. Each time I approach the altar to celebrate Mass, really any time I walk into a church to worship, I am reminded that it was on the hill at Calvary that life began anew for us as followers of Jesus. It was the sacrifice of Jesus that allowed us to experience newness of life. It was on that first Good Friday that we were first called into a that new relationship forged by the blood of Christ. It is in that newness of life, that sacrifice, that relationship, that we know that we are forever united with Christ.

One of my favorite devotions is The Stations of the Cross. It is not so much a favorite because of what it signifies, which is horrific, but of what it gains for us. It allows us to unite our sufferings, our very selves, with the sufferings experienced in the person of Christ. At each station, we begin with a simple (yet profound) prayer: "We adore you, O Christ, and we praise you...Because by Your Holy Cross You have redeemed the world". May we know of Christ's redemptive sacrifice each time we gaze upon the Cross of Christ. May the exaltation we are called to offer on this day lead us to a deeper understanding of, a deeper union with, and a deeper love for Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

MY FRANCISCAN JOURNEY

The Cross is where it begins for St. Francis. Quite simply, without the encounter which St. Francis had with Christ in front of the crucifix at the Church at San Damiano, who knows where his life would have gone. He very likely would have had a (fairly successful and profitable) career as a soldier for a time, after which he would have joined his father selling textiles. After having this meeting with Christ at the foot of the Cross at San Damiano, his whole worldview changed. His life now had purpose and meaning not only in this world, but in the new world to come (the Eternal Kingdom of Christ).

I had the opportunity to stand at the foot of the very Cross at which St. Francis stood. While I didn't have as lifechanging an experience as St. Francis did (I don't foresee myself starting a religious order anytime soon), it was life changing insofar as my own journey into the Franciscan life. It was at that encounter at San Damiano, as well as other encounters had in Assisi, that started me on my road towards profession to the Secular Franciscan Order. I have several Crosses of San Damiano, either purchased or given to me as gifts, which serve as a reminder that I am a Secular Franciscan, a follower of Christ through the intercession of St. Francis, a disciple of Jesus formed in the spirit of "Il Poverello" (the "Little Poor One"). St. Francis was called to "rebuild my (Christ's) church". May we heed the call of Christ to rebuild His Church with the same fervor and zeal with which St. Francis did. On this Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, may we encounter Christ on the Cross and let His love unite ourselves to the world so that they may know of His mercy, His grace, and His love.

If anyone in the parishes has the ability to paint the white areas, (not the steeples) of St. John's, help is truly needed.




